



Barron Electric Cooperative is seeking an individual to fill a full-time Energy Use/Metering Technician position in Barron, Wisconsin. Barron Electric is located in the City of Barron, Wisconsin, whose residents enjoy rural living and larger community services. The City of Barron is also the seat of Barron County, a county of approximately 46,000 residents which combines a rural lifestyle with access to the advantages of several medium and large metro areas. Barron is located approximately 90 miles from the Twin Cities metro area of Minneapolis/St. Paul and 55 miles from the City of Eau Claire, Wisconsin.

The Energy Use/Metering Technician installs and audits the Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) system, exchanges meters, responds to trouble calls, troubleshoots and tests meters, verifies equipment security, investigates power diversions, illegal taps, and maintains chain of evidence from illegal taps, responds to high-bill concerns, obtains and provides meter readings for member billing, and assists in maintaining the Cooperative's load management system.

Minimum Qualifications:

 - High school diploma or equivalent GED.
 - On the job training.
2. Must have and maintain a valid Wisconsin driver's license.
3. Have good English language skills, written and verbal, and basic math skills.
4. Proficient with Microsoft Office; specifically, Excel, Word and PowerPoint.
5. Highly organized and enjoy detail-oriented work requiring accuracy without direct supervision.

Essential Physical Requirements:

1. Ability to drive, repeatedly get in and out of vehicle and walk to meter location in all weather conditions.
2. Perform medium physical work, infrequently lifting up to 50 pounds without assistance.
3. Ability to work in stooped and cramped positions.
4. Must be able to work outdoors and travel occasionally for meetings and assigned duties.
